| Assessment | Grades | Test Description |

| Star Math and Reading Benchmark Assessments | 6-11 | Benchmark assessments are used to determine if student learning is on track for proficiency. Administered every 6 weeks. |
| PSAT 10 | 10 | The PSAT is an optional test for students to gauge readiness for the SAT college entrance exam. Students who do well on the PSAT may be eligible for a National Merit scholarship. Administered October 10, 2018. |
| Semester I Final Exams | 7-12 | This is a comprehensive exam of curriculum covered from September through the end of the semester in January. Final exams are administered in all subjects. Administered: January 16, 2019 (periods 1, 2, and 4) January 17, 2019 (periods 3 and 5) |
| ACT | 11 | The ACT is a commonly used college entrance exam. We strongly encourage all 11th graders take this exam, however it is not required. TrekNorth offers the ACT with Writing, Online. Administration Window: February 26-28, 2019. *Exact date TBD. |
| MCA-III | 6-8, 10, 11 | The MCA-III's are required state assessments designed to test proficiency of the state standards in reading, math, and science. Middle school students are tested in math and reading in grades 6-8, and science in grade 8. High school students are tested on reading standards in grade 10, math |

| Advanced Placement (AP) Exams | <p>9-12</p> <p>*for students enrolled in an AP class and eligible to test.</p> | <p>AP Exams are designed by the College Board to test students knowledge of course learning objectives. Exams are scored by the College Board and students receive a score in July ranging from 1-5. A score of 3 or higher is considered passing, and the student may receive college credit for that course (dependent on college/university policy).</p> <p>Administered May 6, 2019 through May 17, 2019. | Semester II Final Exams | 7-12 | <p>This is a comprehensive exam of curriculum covered during the second semester. Final Exams are administered in all subjects.</p> <p>Administered: May 29, 2019 (periods 1, 2, and 4) May 30, 2019 (periods 3 and 5)</p> |
